Airspace and Other Restrictions

Governador Valadares has a large permanent air space, the SBR 350 IBITURUNA, managed by the City Hall. For the period of competition, CBVL requested its expansion, allowing for a greater variety of tests.

All restricted areas and the boundaries of Notam will be marked on the map and airspace file, "openair.txt" which will be made available.

In general, the overflight of the city of Governador Valadares, northwest of the official landing of the Feira da Paz, coordinate G02 S 18.8585780° / W 41.9415590° , as well as flights within a radius of 03km from the coordinate of the central point of the Airport, R01 S 18.8969680° / W 41.9837170° , are strictly prohibited.

SCORING

GPS Flight Verification.

Only gps that record the 3D altitude component in the tracklog will be accepted.

Organizers will only provide instrument cables with USB input. pilots who have other models must bring their cables in the flight marking. GPS models different from the usual ones, including cell phones, must be presented prior to the competition scorer at the time of registration, who may or may not allow its use for proof of flight, searching along the list of instruments and accepted programs, published by the FAI:

To be considered valid, the gps tracklog must meet the following conditions: It must contain the complete route of the pilot in the race, without interruptions greater than 5 minutes: Pilot must clear tracklog every day on garmin and mlr gps models before to take off; All points must have valid and consistent timestamps with the other points. Continuous points are those that have no more than 30 seconds.

COMPLAINTS AND PROTESTS

If the competitor is not satisfied with the judgment of his claim, he may submit a written protest to the General Judge. Protests must be submitted within a maximum period of one hour after the notification of the result of the claim by the General Judge, upon payment of the fee of R\$ 150.00.

On the last day of the competition, protests must be submitted within the maximum period. 20 (twenty) minutes after notification of the result of the claim by the General Judge.

The General Judge will forward the protest with the history of the complaint and its decision to the Protests Committee, which will handle the case sovereignly, being able to decide for the fee refund.

The Protest Committee will be composed of 03 (three) full members plus 03 (three) alternates, among members of the Technical Directorate for CBVL Competitions and/or experienced pilots.
