3 - Programming

May 06, 2022

18:00h - Registration / Signing of terms of responsibilities / delivery of waypoints.

08:30h - Climb to the ramp (find in front of City Hall)

10:00h - Pilots' signature and delivery of trackers and stolen kit
17:30h to 19:00h - Headquarters (To be defined) to download flight

May 08, 2022

08:30h - Climb to the ramp (find in front of City Hall)
10:00h - Pilots' signature and delivery of trackers and stolen kit
17:30h to 19:00h – Headquarters (To be defined) to download flight
19:30h - Delivery of awards and trophies at Headquarters (To be defined)

Schedules may change and will be released mainly by WhatsApp chat.

Note: the date of the event can be changed to the May 20 to May 22, up to 4 days before the first test.

4 - Subscriptions

The maximum number of entries is 125 with 25% reserved for foreign riders. Vacancies for foreigners will be guaranteed until April 6, 2022. From this date, the available places can be filled by national pilots, according to the order of registration.

According to health standards regarding COVID, this number may decrease.

5 – To compete:

It is mandatory to present a Valid National License (minimum Level II) CBVL, or FAI Card (for foreigners)

6 – Aerosport pilot certificate:

According to Brazilian legislation, all pilots must present an Aerosports Pilot Certificate (ANAC test).

7 – Registration fee

Until April 05, 2022- BRL R\$300.00

From April 05, 2022to May 06, 2022- BRL R\$350.00

Deadline for registration:

May 06, 2022

Possible fees and/or bank charges are not included here.

It is up to the organization to decide whether discounts will apply.

Withdrawals and Cancellations:

The pilot who confirms his registration and is unable to attend the event will comply with the following refund criteria:

- It will not be allowed to transfer seats between pilots.
- The rider who withdraws will give his seat to the first rider on the waiting list.
- Cancellations up to 30 (thirty) days before the event will have the full refund of the registration fee, minus the fees for banking facilities.
- Cancellations between 30 (thirty) days and 15 (fifteen) days before the event will have a refund of 50% of the registration fee, minus the fees for banking facilities.
- Cancellations less than 15 (fifteen) days before the event will not be refunded the registration fee.
- Refunds will be made 7 days after the event ends.

Enrollment includes:

- Registration procedure, waypoint upload;
- Daily transport for the take-off and rescue of pilots on the days of
- valid tests, including for the free practice day;
- Distribution of stolen kit;
- Fellowship Ceremony;
- Competition T-shirt;

8 - Pilot record

- The pilot registration process will take place at the HQ and each pilot must present if requested or have:
- Proof of Identity.
- Evidence that your sail is certified and is within the homologation parameters.

Each competitor must sign:

- Disclaimer Statement
- Declaration of approval of your sail
- Application form

09 - Awards

1st Place Open – BRL R\$1,000.00 + Trophy

2nd Place Open – BRL R\$800.00 + Trophy

3rd Place Open – BRL R\$700.00 + Trophy

SERIAL

1st Place Serial – BRL R\$600.00 + Trophy

2nd Place Serial – BRL R\$550.00 + Trophy

3rd Place Serial – BRL R\$450.00 + Trophy

SPORT

1st Place Sport – BRL R\$400.00 + Trophy

2nd Place Sport – BRL R\$350.00 + Trophy

The possibility of the pilot receiving two awards is vetoed, except for the Female category, if any. The pilot will be obligatorily awarded the prize of the above category, that is, as the prize with the highest value. (Ex.: The pilot flying C-sail is 1st in Sport, 1st in the series and 3rd in the Open; he will automatically enter the Open category getting the 3rd place award in the Open)

11 - Airspace

The disclosure will occur shortly after its publication by the competent body.

10- Windsocks

Will be chosen by the organization

11 - Scoring

The parameters will be the same required in the regulation of the Mineiro Paragliding Championship 2022.

The pilot's score will be based on the relative performance of all. The PWC2019 formula or higher (if available) will be used, with 1000 points based on the distance covered by the first driver, where distance points, time points, points for leadership and points for finishing position are counted, using the software of FS-Comp 2021 R1.2 results calculation (or higher if it meets the most current formula).

Letter System

Calculation and parameters in accordance with the current Regulation of the Brazilian Paragliding Championship of 2022, item 11.3 page 27.

12 - Protests and omissions

We encourage pilots to read the FMVL-Federação Mineira de Voo Livre and CBVL regulations for the Brazilian Championship as this event will follow them as a basis.

The value of the protest is BRL R\$200.00 in cash, and in case of approval, this amount will be fully refunded to the pilot.

Cases not included here or situations that may generate doubts will be discussed by the technical committee of the event based on the regulations mentioned above, and such committee will be formed by:

- Rafael Silva Ferreira Rios, president and has a mining vote
- Michel de Almeida Pinheiro
- Joubert Batista Bitaraes

The commission's premise will be to bring conciliation in cases where the pilot may be harmed in his result due to dubious situations of the regulation or when the regulation proves to be flawed in predicting any chance.

13 -. Sanitary Rules

Participating pilots must follow rules of distancing, use of mask and alcohol gel (the latter made available by the organization in the HQ, rescue cars and on the ramp), and other rules stipulated by the secretary of Health of Caputira.
