REGISTRATIONS

REGISTRATION PROCESS

The administration of registrations is the responsibility of the CBVL Paragliding Competitions Technical Directorate.

The approval of the registration will follow the ranking criteria as described in detail in the 2023 Brazilian Paragliding Championship Regulations. The registration will only be confirmed after approval by the Technical Directorate of Paragliding Competitions of the CBVL and receipt of payment by the CBVL.

The pilot who is on the approved list must pay the registration fee. Failure to pay within 5 days will result in the seat being automatically transferred to the next pilot on the waiting list.

The pilot on the waiting list will receive an e-mail informing the CBVL that he will have up to 5 days to make his payment by PagSeguro, bank slip PIX or PayPal. If payment is not made, the seat will be transferred to the next pilot on the waiting list, and so on.

It is the pilot's responsibility to keep his e-mail address up to date in the CBVL system registration, as it will be through this e-mail that he will be communicated about the release of his vacancy. The rider can also check the status of his clearance in the list of riders published on the event page.

AVAILABLE VACANCIES

Following the regulation of the Brazilian Paragliding Championship 2023

90 first classified in the 1st Stage of the current year;

03 female vacancies according to the ranking of competitors in the 1st Stage of the current year;

02 CBVL Wildcards (at the discretion of the CBVL Competitions Technical Board);

30 Vacancies for foreigners - if they are not reverted to the following in the 1st Stage (96° onwards).

ENROLLMENT

Registration Fee: BRL 1,200 + Taxation

Date: June 19th to 28th

Included:

Safety, retrieve and health structure;

Snack kit, t-shirt, numeral sticker, etc;

Transportation to the takeoff during the 7 days of competition + training day;

Retrieve on the main highways in the axis of the tests;

Use of CBVL trackers as well as the entire structure of the competition.

REIMBURSEMENT

Procedure as described below:

Payment cancellation over 60 days from the event date – 75% of the amount

Cancellation of payment between 30-60 days of the event date – 50% of the amount

Cancellation between 30 and 7 days before the event date – 25% of the amount

Special cases such as accidents and/or medical conditions with a certificate must be sent by email to the CBVL secretariat, which will forward it to the registration committee, which will decide which reimbursement amount is the most appropriate. Cancellations made less than 7 days before the event, under any circumstances, will not be refunded.

BIRUTAS

Biruta riders must be previously registered as a Biruta with the General Judge and the organization of the event.

The flight will be allowed before the competition, with the authorization of the General Judge. The windsack pilot must obligatorily use the radio at the determined frequency, obeying the landing guidance at the time of the Start or not advancing to the test.

FREEFLY

The Free Fly modality will not be adopted, however after the takeoff window closes, non-registered pilots will be able to take off aware that because they do not participate in the event, they will not be able to use the redemption or any other benefit provided by the organization.

STICKERS FOR NUMBERS

It will be mandatory that each pilot entered in the championship has his number highlighted on the paraglider. The stickers will be provided by the stage organizer, during accreditation at the HQ. The number will be assigned to the pilot upon confirmation of registration, determined by the ranking of the previous year. If you want a different number, you must request it from the CBVL within 15 days before the start of the stage. After flying the first stage, the number can no longer be modified.

Reading and becoming aware of all the rules contained in the regulation is the sole responsibility of the pilot, subjecting himself to the penalties provided for therein.

TAKE OFF

Pilots must respect the areas marked out for checking equipment without jeopardizing the space reserved for take off. The General Judge has the authority to disqualify and/or penalize in points the pilot who insists on remaining in the take-off corridor.

It is only allowed to take off from places previously approved and signaled by the organization, which have adequate safety features. Pilots who decide to take off from improvised places that are not officially approved will be disqualified from the test.

GENERAL COMMUNICATION

Whatsapp will be the official communication vehicle for the Competition. Through it, the Organization will send all official information before and during the event.

CELL PHONE

Cell phone with Whatsapp is mandatory item. The phone number must be recorded on your registration form as a personal security item. The best GSM cell phone coverage in the region is provided by operator Vivo.

RADIO HT

Radio with charged batteries for use throughout the day and in full conditions of use on all flights, is a mandatory item.

Retrieve: 144.550 MHz

Flight and Emergency: 144.750 MHz

Report Back, mandatory up to 30 minutes after landing, can be performed by:
